Johannesburg OR Tambo International Airport is the busiest airport on the continent of Africa and is situated in the Kempton Park district of Johannesburg, 23 km north-west of the city centre and 46 km south of Pretoria city centre.

Formerly, Jan Smuts Airport, it has been renamed in honour of the late and former ANC President, Oliver Reginald Tambo, who was more commonly referred to by the name of OR Tambo. Johannesburg OR Tambo International Airport is one of the few airports in the world with scheduled passenger direct flights between all 6 inhabited continents and also serves as a continental gateway to many sub-Saharan countries.



Weigh-in and measurements will be conducted at Heartfelt Arena, Voortrekker Road, Pretoria, South Africa.

REGISTRATION FEES AND PAYMENTS

South African Athletes:

South African Athletes: IFBB Registration Fee of USD \$150 if registered in advance, online. USD \$200, if paid at the registration.

International Athletes:

IFBB Registration Fee of USD \$250 if registered in advance, online. USD \$300 if athletes register on Friday, 16 May 2025. The deadline date for online payment is 7 May 2025. On the 7th of May 2025, at 24:00 hrs (midnight - Central European Summer Time, UTC +2) the online payment system will be switched off.

- Remember that all athletes will have to produce their IFBB International Card at registration. Any athlete who has not yet purchased or renewed their IFBB International Card will have to buy one at registration. IFBB Cards are EUR €40 or USD \$50 and are mandatory.
- If an athlete wants to participate in additional categories, the registration fee for each of the additional categories is USD \$100.

Possible crossovers:

- Men's Classic Bodybuilding Classic Physique – Bodybuilding;
- Women's Bikini Women's Fit-Model;
- Women's Wellness Women's Fit-Model.
- Also junior and masters in senior classes.
- Men's Physique Men's Fit-Model

How to register in the competition:

- 1. Be a member of your national federation.
- 2. Follow qualification rules set by your federation.
- 3. Register as an International Athlete, paying your IFBB Blue Book at 2025 PSSACup | IFBB (ifbb-registration.com)
- 4. Request to attend the competition from your profile.
- 5. Register for the competition and pay the Registration Fee before the deadline provided in the Inspection Report.
- Use your personal access code to download the liability form and upload music.

Each athlete should have the following at registration:

- ID Document
- IFBB International Card (Blue Book)
- Music in the MP3 format on audio CD or USB memory, clearly marked with name + division. Only 1 song on the CD or USB.

IMPORTANT NOTICE:

The use of profane, vulgar or offensive language is strictly prohibited in posing music, otherwise you will be asked to leave the stage.









The number of participating athletes is **UNLIMITED**. Registration of athletes will only be considered if they are nominated by their IFBB-affiliated National Federation.

Once the Entry form from the National Federation has been received and accepted, an official letter will be sent to the National Federation confirming the participation of its National Team enter in the 2025 President Santonja Africa Cup. Those teams or athletes who have not met the established requirements or who missed the deadline for registration, will also be notified that they will be unable to participate in this competition. The final decision to allow an athlete to compete in this event rests with the IFBB.

The deadline for submitting Final Entry Forms is 10 May 2025 We strongly encourage you to register early and make the appropriate arrangements to compete in the 2025 President Santonja African Cup and Women's African Championships. South African Athletes will have to qualify and be recommended by the IFBB SA Head Office. South African athletes will enter through the link on the IFBB International web page and make payment to IFBB International via PayPal.

PLEASE BE AWARE

It is full responsibility and obligation of the national federation to verify if each of the athletes to be registered on this international event are not suspended or have any violation action against the competitior due to anti-doping rule violations or any disciplinary case at national or international level.







JUDGES

To be taken into consideration during selection of judges panels at the competition, IFBB International Judges must be included in the Final Entry Forms sent by National Federations, according to the IFBB Rules.

AWARDS & WINNING IFBB PRO CARDS

Overalls will run directly after the awarding ceremony in the last category of each of the following divisions:

IFBB Elite Pro Cards will be offered for the winners of the following overall categories (through their National Federation.

- Men's Physique (top 3)
- Men's Classic Bodybuilding (top 3)
- Men's Bodybuilding (top 3)
- Women's Physique (the winner)
- Women's Bodyfitness (top 3)
- Women's Bikini (top 3)
- Women's Wellness (top 3)

The winner of the IFBB Pro Card has 1 year to take up the Card. If the athlete hasn't done this, he/she will have to qualify once again to turn Pro. Minimum number of competitors to run a category should be 3. If less than 3 athletes, categories will be combined, wherever possible.

AWARDS

- Top six athletes in each category will be awarded with medals.
- Top six athletes in each category will be awarded with the IFBB Certificate of Excellence.
- Winner of each category will be awarded with a trophy.
- Overall winner in each division will be awarded with a trophy.

- Top 5 athletes in Men's and Women's senior categories will be awarded points to the 2025 IFBB World Ranking, according to the World Ranking Rules (level 2).
- IFBB Elite Pro Cards for the top three overall category winners in Men's Bodybuilding, Men's Classic Bodybuilding, Men's Physique, Women's Bodyfitness, Women's Bikini, Women's Wellness and for the Women's Physique overall winner (after applications through their National Federaions).




